1. In the classroom




Sew it to save it

Cut a piece of thread that is approximately 2 foot long (2 rulers). Thread the needle so the thread is even on both sides and tie a knot in the end.

Position your *Green Football's Great Save* badge. Start with the needle at the BACK of the badge, so the knot stays behind, and thread it all the way through till you hit the knot.

Sew all around the edge, using evenly spaced stitches until you reach the starting point. After you've sewn around, tie a knot at the back by looping the thread through a stitch, pull tight and cut off any extra thread.



3. Ginormous jumble sale

Clear our lost property and unused sports kit! Host a school-wide jumble sale or swap shop, raise money for your school and donate non-uniform leftovers to the Salvation Army, by signing up to their 'Recycle With Michael' scheme
